

# How to write for science.

When writing for science remember to:

- be **clear, accurate and concise**
  - *no unnecessary detail or ambiguous language.*
- write in an **impersonal and active voice**
  - *keep the writing formal and depersonalised.*
- use **objective language** rather than subjective language.
- write in **past tense**, or combined tense, depending on the purpose for writing.
- use **technical terms and vocabulary** to describe the concepts, features and processes of science.
- support any assertions, ideas and statements with **evidence**.
- **sequence** and connect your ideas logically.
  - *use headings to create clear sections.*
